**Minutes of the meetings of EC held on 22.11.2016 and 29.11.2016 with reference to (i) Events Abroad (Commodities) for the period April – September, 2017; and (ii) Services Sector events abroad 2017-18**

The following were decided as **policy guidelines**:

- 1.1 Keeping in view the evolving trends, proposals henceforth should be submitted covering commodities and related services jointly, if necessary by joining hands with other trade organizations (e.g. TEPC has synergy with ESCEPC for mobile telephony)
- 1.2 For participation in events abroad, the Trade Organizations, other than EPCs, would henceforth cease to submit proposals for commodities / markets without specific focus. Such organizations would also be expected to develop their core competence on such verticals / markets by developing expertise within the organization.
- 1.3 The approval for all events abroad would be based on the principle of the average of the funding done in the last two years, territory-wise (applicable for all 10 territories). The fund indicated in the Sub-Committee recommendations would accordingly, be treated as approved based on such a calibration. Any exception to this principle would be given only based on cogent reasoning / justification.
- 1.4 Different agencies participating in one event would ensure that the hiring of space and the India branding is common for the event and it would be ensured that separate pavilions are not created unless the participation is in the pavilions relating to the specific verticals.
- 1.5 Wherever two agencies are jointly funded, the agency mobilising the larger participation would be the lead agency for the event.
- 1.6 Ministry of Textiles should look into the MAI funding to EPCs of Textiles sector and shall ensure that there is no overlapping of funds given under MAI and the grants given by DC (Handicrafts) / DC (Handlooms) or any other authority under Ministry of Textiles.
- 1.7 The outcome report of an event shall be indicative of the business trend. It shall invariably include the number of Indian participants participating in an event and as to how many of them are participating on self-financing basis and how many with Govt. support.

## **2. WANA proposals 2017-18**

All the events were treated as approved subject to the following modifications:

- 2.1 For Sl. No. 2 of Agenda Note, SRTEPC would ensure participation of 50 and FIEO would support SRTEPC.
- 2.2 For Sl. No. 5 of Agenda Note, various verticals of healthcare will be covered. SEPC would be the lead partner with Pharmexcil / FICCI as support partners.
- 2.3 For Sl. No. 7 of Agenda Note, a joint event of Agri and Plantation Division would be organized. TPCI will be the lead partner.
- 2.4 For Sl. No. 15 of Agenda Note, the proposal was approved with ICC as the lead agency bringing 50 participants and EPCH would garner 25.

## **3. Europe proposals 2017-18**

All the events were treated as approved subject to the following modifications:

- 3.1 For Sl. No. 3 of Agenda Note, TEXPROCIL would ensure participation of 60; thirty (30) would be funded by Government of India.
- 3.2 For Sl. No. 9 of Agenda Note, TEPC would also join. ESCEPC and TEPC to mobilize participation of 35 and 25 exhibitors respectively.
- 3.3 For Sl. No. 12 of Agenda Note, EEPC would join ACMA with additional participation of 20 (total 50).
- 3.4 For Sl. No. 13 of Agenda Note, CLE would participate with 70. Funding is limited to 25 participants.
- 3.5 For Sl. No. 17 of Agenda Note, EEPC would explore participation from other agencies to increase the number from 25.
- 3.6 For Sl. No. 23 of Agenda Note, ISEPC would increase the participation to 40.
- 3.7 For Sl. No. 24 of Agenda Note, participation to be increased to 30 by EPCH.
- 3.8 The proposal of ISEPC regarding 1<sup>st</sup> Asia Apparel Show, though recommended by SC, inadvertently left out from the agenda, was also approved.

## **4. NAFTA proposals 2017-18**

All the proposals were approved subject to the following modifications:

- 4.1 ICC and TEXPROCIL would jointly participate (Sl. No. 9 and Sl. No. 14 of Agenda Note) with a total participation of 65.

- 4.2 CLE would desist from seeking funds for Las Vegas participation from 2018-19. They would explore markets like China, Indonesia for future events.
- 4.3 The proposal of Carpet EPC regarding Source Direct, USA, moved as per recommendation of SC, was approved.

## **5. CIS proposals 2017-18**

It was noted that there is a tendency to focus on Russia for participation in CIS. FIEO offered to do an exercise to identify events in markets other than Russia for 2017-18 and revert with their findings. All the proposals in the agenda were approved.

## **6. Proposals of NEA Region**

The Committee took the following decisions regarding proposals relating to NEA:

- 6.1 EPCH dropped its proposal at Sl. No.3 of Agenda Note.
- 6.2 EP (Engg) was asked to examine whether the event at Sl. No.14 of Agenda Note can be held in India. EP (Engg) has advised that this event may be sanctioned as it is specific to auto components sector and the proposed modality is in line with the practice in the sector. The proposal is accordingly approved.
- 6.3 EEPC will increase the number of participants for the event at Sl. No.15 of Agenda Note to 40.
- 6.4 The number of Indian exhibitors participating in the event at Sl. No.17 of Agenda Note will be increased to 40.
- 6.5 HEPC is taking 50 Indian participants to event at Sl. No.26 of Agenda Note. Funding would be for 30 participants.
- 6.6 The number of Indian exhibitors participating in the event at Sl. No.27 of Agenda Note will be increased to 30.

## **7. Proposals of ASEAN Region**

As regards ASEAN proposals, the Committee decided as under:

- 7.1 SRTEPC dropped proposal at Sl. No.16 of Agenda Note and requested that in place of this proposal its proposal for participating in an event in Russia may be accepted. EC approved this.
- 7.2 Other proposals of ASEAN region, as recommended by SC, were approved.

## **8. Proposals of Africa Region**

As regards Africa proposals, the Committee decided as under:

- 8.1. Pharmexcil, SEPC and EEPC shall come together and move proposals for organising events in Healthcare sector in Africa. FICCI shall also join.
- 8.2. SEPC shall partner with ASSOCHAM for the event at Sl. No.9 of Agenda Note, for consultancy services relating to Building and Constructions sectors.
- 8.3. The number of participants for the CLE event at Sl. No.13 of Agenda Note increased to 40.
- 8.4. All other proposals of Africa region were approved.

## **9. Proposals of LAC Region**

EC considered the proposals recommended by SC regarding LAC and decided as under:

- 9.1 Proposals at Sl. No.17 and 18 of Agenda Note relating to Venezuela dropped.
- 9.2 All BSMs relating to LAC should be combined and EEPC, ACMA and FIEO may move proposals for such combined BSM with EEPC as lead agency. FT (LAC) Division to examine in consultation with EPCs and Trade Promotion Organisations and revert.
- 9.3 For Healthcare Sector, a joint delegation of SEPC / FICCI / Pharmexcil / EEPC shall be organized for Brazil, Colombia, Peru, Chile.
- 9.4 The number of participants in the event organised by Texprocil (Sl. No.5 of Agenda Note) increased to 30.
- 9.5 All other proposals of LAC region were approved.

## **10. Proposals of SA Region**

Regarding South Asia proposals, EC decided as under:

- 10.1 EEPC will join ACMA for event at Sl. No.14 of Agenda Note, with combined strength of 50 Indian participants.
- 10.2 In the event at Sl. No.16 of Agenda Note, SRTEPC participate with 20 exporters and Pdexcil with 30 exporters with Pdexcil as lead agency.
- 10.3 All other proposals relating to South Asia approved as proposed by SC.

## **11. Proposals of Oceania Region**

EC considered the proposals of Oceania region and decided as under:

- 11.1 FIEO shall partner with CLE for event at Sl. No.3 of Agenda Note, with combined strength of 50 Indian participants.
- 11.2 All other proposals relating to Oceania approved as proposed by SC.

## **12. Proposals of Services Sector**

- 12.1 The Committee felt that the Services Sector proposals need to be re-examined. Services EPC shall go through the proposals of Healthcare Sector relating to various regions, not specifically included under Service Sector proposals, and to examine whether Healthcare services can be integrated into them. Further the need to have two RBSMs for Multi Services also need to be re-examined. Services Division, DoC shall re-examine the proposals of Services Sector and revert by 02.12.2016.
- 12.2 Based on the above, proposals of the services sector were re-examined by JS(MAI) on 16.12.2016.
