**Minutes of the meeting of EC of MAI held on 04.07.2017**

List of participants is given at Annex-I.

**A. Proposals of EPCs, not considered earlier by EC**

1. **AEPC**: No representative of Ministry of Textiles was present during the meeting. The proposals at serial No.2, 3 and 5 approved. Proposals regarding RBSM in Delhi in January, 2018 (Sl. No.1) and Sourcing at Magic, Las Vegas (Sl. No.4) are to be decided on the basis of its proportionate share in exports. In any case, since for Textiles India 2017, AEPC has been provided a sum of Rs.5.84 crore, no further RBSM will be considered.
2. **WWEPC**: The proposal regarding Intergift Exhibition, Spain (Sl. No.7) approved.
3. **SGEPC**: All three proposals listed in the agenda approved.
4. **Capexil**: The proposal to participate in the Flooring Show, UK in September, 2017 approved with joint participation of Capexil and CII with 40 and 35 participants respectively. Capexil will be the lead agency.
5. **IOPEPC/APEDA**:
  - (i) **Anuga, Germany, October, 2017**: EC approved MAI assistance of Rs.1.50 crore to APEDA. Assistance of Rs.33.75 lakh was also approved for IOPEPC participation in the event with 15 participants. Various agencies of this Department are participating in the event. EP (Agri) to coordinate with ITPO, APEDA, IOPEPC, MPEDA and other agencies to ensure that their stalls and pavilions are contiguous.
  - (ii) IOPEPC would participate with APEDA/TPCI in Gulfood, Dubai (Sl. No.14) and Alimentaria Mexico (Sl. No.15). EP (Agri) to coordinate. Since World Food Moscow is not an approved event, IOPEPC may also not participate in this.

- (iii) Separate RBSM at Agra (Sl. No.16) was not approved. IOPEPC was advised to merge with Indus Food, 2018.
- (iv) The proposal to organise BSM in China with 25 participants approved. FT (NEA) and EP (Agri) to coordinate with Indian Embassy for value addition.
- (v) The capacity building programmes approved.

#### **B. Additional Proposals 2017-18 – RBSM**

6. **CAP India 2017** (Sl. No.19): The request to reduce the numbers was not approved. Concerned EPCs were advised to ensure that the event is organised as per EP (CAP) Division's advice. Any shortfall would attract penal reduction in MAI grant.
7. **Vastra 2017** (Sl. No.20): EC in principle approved the proposal. Final approval would be on the basis of region-wise break up of participants to be provided by FICCI. FICCI to make a presentation on the proposal, after which matter would be processed on file.
8. **Higher Education Summit** (Sl. No.21): The proposal approved. Services Division to coordinate with FICCI and Services EPC.
9. **RBSM Coinciding Vibrant Ceramics, Gandhinagar** (Sl. No.22): The proposal of ICC approved. Capexil will not be participating in the event.
10. **Act India Business Show, 2017**: the proposal approved.
11. CLE RBSM proposals at Sl. No.24 and 25 not approved, being too small.
12. **International Arogya and Wellness Fair**: The proposal approved in principle. FICCI, SEPC and Pharmexcil to sort out issues regarding participation in the event and revert to Department of Commerce. FICCI to make a presentation on the proposal, Ministry of AYUSH also to be invited. Matter would be processed on file after the presentation.

### **C. Additional Proposals 2017-18: Events Abroad**

13. The proposals to organise 'Source India' in Nigeria, Argentina and Iran, jointly by TPCI, ASSOCHAM, ESCEPC, TEPC and Capexil approved, with TPCI as lead agency.
14. Proposals of Textiles EPC to be approved only if the assistance already approved for them is short of initial ceilings fixed on the basis of their proportionate share in exports. Accordingly, the matter was considered on file and the following decision taken:
- (i) AEPC: The proposals at Sl. No.2, 3 and 5 of the agenda note approved. Proposals at Sl. No.1 and 4 of the agenda note not approved.
  - (ii) WWEPC: The proposal at Sl. No.6 of the agenda note not approved and Sl. No.7 approved.
  - (iii) Texprocil: The proposal at Sl. No.30 of the agenda note approved.
  - (iv) HEPC: The proposal at Sl. No.37 of the agenda note not approved.
  - (v) ISEPC: The proposal at Sl. No.38 and 54 of the agenda note not approved.
  - (vi) SRTEPC: The proposal at Sl. No.39 of the agenda note approved.
15. MAI Division to obtain report from the concerned embassies regarding the quality of participation, business generated, etc in respect of all BSMs being organised by EPC's/Chambers, etc.
16. Due to space constraints, Chemexcil and Shefexil will jointly participate with 50 participants in Interdye Asia Exhibition, Indonesia (Sl. No.44). If organisers provide additional space, they would take 10 more participants.
17. FICCI to coordinate with DIPP regarding Theme Pavilion in ASEAN – India Expo & Forum (Sl. No.46)
18. Best of India Show, Azerbaijan (Sl. No.49) to be made into a multi-product event with a minimum of 100 participants. Other EPCs can also join in this event. FT (CIS) to coordinate.
19. Details of decision in respect to each proposal is at **Annexure-II**.

**D. Proposals already approved by EC : modification cases**

20. Proposals of TEPC (Sl. No.56) and ACMA (Sl. No.57) approved.

21. **59<sup>th</sup> Brno International Engineering Fair:** EC in principle approved. Proposal to be processed on file along with costing etc for final approval.

22. **Advantage Healthcare India:** Dates of the event to be decided by FICCI and other participants. JS (ARR) and JS (SP) to hold a meeting to sort out the issues. It was clarified that this Department is committed to one big event in Healthcare sector and multiple events would not be supported under MAI. Russia to participate as Partner Country and ASEAN as partner Region [concerned Territorial Divisions will take necessary action].
