Minutes of the IMC meeting under the Chairmanship of Shri Binoy Kumar, Special Secretary (Logistics) held on 10-04-2018 for consideration of proposals for setting up of Inland Container Depots(ICDs) / Container Freight Stations(CFSs) / Air Freight Stations (AFSs)

A meeting of the Inter-Ministerial Committee (IMC) was held on 10-04-2018 in Udyog Bhavan, New Delhi under the Chairmanship of Shri Binoy Kumar, Special Secretary (Logistics), Department of Commerce, for consideration of proposals for setting up of Inland Container Depots(ICDs)/Container Freight Stations(CFSs)/Air Freight Stations (AFSs) in India. Following officials participated in the meeting: -

- 1. Shri Satya Srinivas, Joint Secretary (Customs), Department of Revenue
- 2. Ms. Vandana Aggarwal, Economic Advisor, Ministry of Civil Aviation
- 3. Shri Prabhas Dansana, Executive Director (TTS), Ministry of Railways
- 4. Shri B. Praveen, Director (Infrastructure) Department of Commerce
- 5. Shri D. K. Rai, Director, Ministry of Shipping
- 6. Shri Shyam Lal, Under Secretary, Department of Commerce
- 7. Shri M. Rama Pratap, Section Officer, Infra-I Section.
- 2. In his opening remarks the Special Secretary (Logistics)/Chairman IMC welcomed all the participants and informed that this was the last meeting of IMC as a decision has already been taken that the requirement of IMC constituted in 1992 does not exist today in view of changed circumstances of development of infrastructure like ports, roads, etc and emphasis on DPD / DPE and faster and easier trading across border as part of Ease of Doing Business.
- 5. The decision to de-notify the IMC was conveyed by the Commerce Secretary to the Secretaries of the Ministries who are members of the IMC vide letter dated 28-03-2018 The members acknowledged the receipt of the communication and informed that necessary action was being taken by them.
- 6. In the light of the above, members of the IMC agreed that the following action has to be further taken at the earliest to ensure continuity in process of setting up of such custom bonded facilities: -
  - (i) Central Board of Indirect Taxes and Customs (CBIC) to issue their policy guidelines on the setting up of the ICD/CFS/AFS as required;
  - (ii) Directions to be issued by CBIC to all concerned official including the jurisdictional Custom Commissioners regarding the process of grant of extension of LoI and that may henceforth not insist on an LoI from the Department of Commerce;
  - (iii) CBIC to amend the Customs Manual indicating the process of submission of applications for setting up of ICDs/CFSs/AFSs;
  - (iv) Ministry of Civil Aviation to amend the AFS Policy guidelines regarding the process of setting up of AFSs and extension of Letters of Intents (Lols) of AFSs, in consultation with CBIC.
- 7. The IMC was informed that no new applications are being accepted on the online portal.

8. The proposals in the agenda/supplementary agenda which included all the cases pending before the IMC were deliberated upon by the IMC and decision taken accordingly: -

#### (i) Cases approved by IMC:

The application for setting up of ICD at Vernama, Dist. Vadodara, Gujarat by CONCOR (F. No. 16/29/2016-infra-I) was approved for issue of LoI as all the IMC members have concurred to the proposal. The conditions to be stipulated in the LoI were to include the setting up of RFID scanners / readers as required by DMICDC.

#### (ii) Cases not approved by IMC:

- (a) JS(Customs) informed that the government has decided to extend the DPD/DPE facilities to the all the ports. After its implementation at JNPT and Chennai ports, he mentioned that this is now to be implemented in the Mundra and Visakhapatnam ports. JS(Customs) also clarified that the implementation of DPD / DPE facilities at Chennai port were extended to include the Ennore and Kattupalli ports as they form the same ecosystem. In this framework, IMC was of the view that in line with its decision taken in respect of the proposals at JNPT and Chennai, all the proposals at Mundra and Visakhapatnam are not to be considered for approval.
- (b) IMC decided that in all cases where the there was no viability of the project no approval is to be granted.
- (c) JS(Customs) opined that the concept of CFS being attached to an ICD was under review. He mentioned that with new technologies the criteria of space and equipment are to be considered afresh. The guidelines for such proposals would be spelt out in the new guidelines to be issued shortly. In view of the above, the IMC decided that such cases are not to be granted approval and may apply afresh as per the guidelines to be issued shortly.

#### (iv) Extension of Letters of Intent:

The Members of the IMC opined that CBIC and Ministry of Civil Aviation will take time to issue guidelines regarding procedure for setting up of new facilities and processing of the cases of extension. It was also observed that some of the LoIs have lapsed as no meeting of the IMC was held in the recent past. In view of this, IMC decided to grant extensions as per the following guiding principles:

- (a) All proposals of AFS to be granted an extension of one year;
- (b) All proposals seeking extension for the first time may be granted an extension of one year;
- (c) All remaining proposals be granted an extension of six months.

The applicants / their representatives were informed of the de-notification of the IMC. It was further informed to all the applicants / their representatives that all cases of extension of LoI would in future be dealt with by CBIC.

Based on the above guiding principles, IMC decided to extend the validity of LoIs of the following cases, included in the agenda / supplementary agenda upto the period mentioned against each case:-
