

Minutes of the meeting of the Empowered Committee (EC) on ASIDE held at 2.30 p.m. on 05.08.2008 under the Chairmanship of Shri G.K. Pillai, Secretary, Department of Commerce, in conference room no. 141, Udyog Bhawan, New Delhi.

2. Welcoming the participants, Sh. Neeraj Kumar Gupta, Joint Secretary stated that Budget provision of Rs. 570 crore has been made under ASIDE Scheme for the year 2008-09. As per ASIDE Guidelines 80% of the fund i.e. Rs. 456 crore has been provisionally allocated to States/UTs under State Component and the balance 20% i.e. Rs. 114 crore has been earmarked for the Central Component of ASIDE scheme. An amount of Rs. 13 crore has been earmarked for being released to North Eastern States. Against availability of funds under Central Component, we have committed liability of Rs. 230.51 crore for the ongoing projects approved by Empowered Committee in preceding years and have received 42 new projects seeking financial assistance of Rs. 221.79 crore. He stated that above necessitate to priorities the ongoing as well as new projects from the angle of its criticality for export and actual requirement of funds during current financial year.

Rs. 9.54 crores have subsequently been released to APEDA, during the previous financial year, subject to ex-post facto approval of the Empowered Committee

- (ii) The proposal of CLE for undertaking Animal Welfare Projects in West Bengal and Karnataka was approved by the Empowered committee on ASIDE in the meeting held on

1st June 2005 with an assistance of Rs. 43.50 lakhs under Central Component of ASIDE. The grant was released subsequently. CLE, however, could utilize only Rs. 10 lakhs out of Rs. 43.50 lakhs due to non-execution of certain parts of the projects. CLE surrendered the balance amount of Rs. 33.50 lakhs. Finance Division and EP (LSG) conveyed their no objection on abandoning the project and the acceptance of the unutilized amount. It has been decided to seek the formal approval of the Empowered Committee to allow CLE closing the project.

- (iii) A Study on feasibility Report on development of Integarted Check Post (ICP) at Sherathang (Gangtok) alongwith Indo-China Border was commissioned by Infra II to RITES Ltd. at a cost of Rs. 18 lakhs. Commerce Secretary had approved to meet the cost of study from ASIDE funds. The draft report had been submitted by the RITES and the same was circulated to concerned Departments for their comments. RITES had submitted a bill of Rs. 16,17,984 towards the preparation of the Report.

(Also enlisted for release of Rs. 8,08,992 to RITES)

- (iv) The proposal of Cochin SEZ for project of the construction of storm water drain from the Zone to nearest irrigation canal was approved by the Empowered Committee on ASIDE in the meeting held on 07.11.2006 with an assistance of Rs. 20.25 lakhs under Central Component of ASIDE and the grant was released. Subsequently CSEZ requested to sanction an additional amount of Rs. 11.25 lakhs for the project due to revision of the cost. The request of CSEZ was approved by Commerce Secretary on File. Rs. 11.25 lakhs have been released to CSEZ during the previous financial year. The grant needs to be ratified by the Empowered Committee on ASIDE
- (v) Proposals of Madras EPZ for infrastructure projects during 2005-06 and 2006-07 were approved in the meetings of Empowered Committee and funds were released subsequently. Lateron one Project, the establishment of 33/11 KV EB Substation, was executed by the Tamilnadu Electricity Board at their own cost and the MEPZ undertook revised activities with the released ASIDE funds. The revision of activities and expenditure patter by MEPZ was approved by Commerce Secretary on File. The approval needs to be ratified by the Empowered Committee on ASIDE.
