

MINUTES OF THE 1ST MEETING (FY 2011-12) OF THE EMPOWERED COMMITTEE (EC) ON ASIDE SCHEME UNDER THE CHAIRMANSHIP OF COMMERCE SECRETARY HELD ON 26.7.2011 (TUESDAY) AT 11:00 AM IN ROOM NO. 141, UDYOG BHAVAN, NEW DELHI

EC met with Dr Rahul Khullar, Commerce Secretary in chair, on 26.7.2011 in Room No. 141, Udyog Bhawan. A list of participants is at Annex-1.

2. Shri Ravi Capoor, Joint Secretary welcomed participants and informed the EC that for the year 2011-12, Rs. 850.96 crore have been allocated under ASIDE Scheme. As per ASIDE Guidelines, 80% of these funds i.e. Rs.680.00 crore have been earmarked for State Component and balance 20% of the total allocation i.e. Rs. 170.96 crore are to be allocated under the Central Component of ASIDE. Of these funds, an amount of Rs. 05.65 crore has been utilized so far leaving a balance of Rs.165.31 Cr. under this head. A total of 11 deferred projects, 29 new projects and 21 ongoing projects were submitted for consideration of EC.

2.1 Commerce Secretary at the outset made the following observations:

- (i) The funds available under the Central Component are only 20% of the total allocation under the ASIDE Scheme. 80% of the ASIDE allocation is allocated to the State Governments for projects to be decided on by SLEPC of the respective State Governments.
As the funds under the Central Component of the ASIDE scheme are extremely limited, utilization of such funds is therefore to be made in such a manner which adheres to the spirit of the ASIDE guidelines and ensures most effective achievement of the objectives of ASIDE.
- (ii) Since very limited resources are available in the Central Component, infrastructure projects and activities which are the primary responsibility of the State cannot be considered for funding under the Central Component of ASIDE.
- (iii) All agencies funded under ASIDE (Central Component) should ensure that UCs of all completed projects and UCs due are submitted latest by 15.08.2011.
- (iv) In case of ongoing projects where UCs are not due, a detailed report of the physical and financial progress of the project should be sent urgently to facilitate timely release of balance / next installment of ASIDE assistance.
