

Minutes of the meeting of Inter Ministerial Committee (IMC) for consideration of proposals for setting up of ICDs/CFSs held under the Chairmanship of Shri M. Prasad, Additional Secretary (Infrastructure), Department of Commerce on 6th June, 2013

Inter Ministerial Committee (IMC) met on 06.06.2013 in Udyog Bhavan, New Delhi, with Shri M. Prasad, Additional Secretary, DoC in Chair, for consideration of proposals for setting up of Inland Containers Depots(ICDs)/Container Freight Stations (CFSs) in India. I : RATIFICATION OF THE MINUTES OF THE IMC MEETING HELD ON 06-03-2013

IMC ratified the minutes of IMC Meeting held on 06.03.2013.

II: DEFFERED PROPOSAL OF IMC MEETING DATED 14.03.2012

1. **Setting up of a CFS at Kalamassery, Kochi, Kerala by M/s. Periyar Chemicals Ltd. (F.No. 16/26/2011-Infra 1)**

IMC approved the project.

III. Proposal last considered in IMC meeting dated 27.11.2012

2. **Setting up of a CFS at Kanithi Village, near Gangavaram Port, Vishakhapatnam Distt., Andhra Pradesh by VPL Integral CFS Pvt. Ltd. (F. No. 16/23/2012-Infra-I)**

IMC approved the project.

IV: DEFFERED PROPOSALS OF IMC MEETING DATED 06.03.2013

3. **Setting up of ICD at Modi Nagar, U.P. by Kribhco Infrastructure Ltd. (F.No. 16/18/2010-Infra 1)**

IMC approved the project.

4. Setting up of ICD at Jaipur, Rajasthan by Hasti Petro-Chemicals and Shipping Ltd. (F. No. 16/21/2012-Infra 1)

IMC granted 'in principle' approval for three months and directed the company representative to complete registration of land, seek PFT permission from Railways and follow up the matter with CBEC within this period.

5. Setting up of Rail-linked ICD at Kashipur US Nagar by M/s. Kashipur Infrastructure and Freight Terminal Pvt. Ltd. (F. No.16/18/2012-Infra-I)

IMC approved the project subject to furnishing of sale / lease deed. This would be the first ICD in Uttarakhand.

6. Change of Name from Shri Balaji Warehousing And Pest Control Services Pvt. Ltd. to SBW Logistics Pvt. Ltd. (F. No. 16/33/2009-Infra-I)

IMC decided to examine the case on file.

7. Change of name of the Company Inland Conware Private Limited to Adani Logistics Limited. (F. No. 16/07/2006-Infra-I)

IMC decided to examine the case on file.

8. Sical Distriparks Ltd. merging with Sical Multimodal and Rail Transport Ltd.- CFS Division. (F. No. 16/28/2008-Infra 1)

IMC decided to examine the case on file.

VI. CHANGE OF CUSTODIANSHIP CASES

9. Change of custodianship from M/s. ETA Engineering Pvt. Ltd. to Vikram Logistics & Maritime Services (P) Ltd. (F. No. 16/26/2009-Infra 1)

IMC decided to examine the case on file.

VII. EXTENSION OF LOI CASES

10. Setting up of Rail Linked ICD at Hyderabad by M/s Allcargo Logistics Ltd. (File No. 16/34/2007-Infra-I)

IMC discussed the case and decided that extension of LOI will be granted after receiving the final order of Hon'ble High Court of Andhra Pradesh. Company representative was asked to submit the final Order of High Court of Andhra Pradesh and to clarify if the company has submitted application to get rail-siding.

11. Sattva Conware Private Ltd.-Extension of validity of LOI (for the fifth time) by six months w.e.f. 31.3.13 to 30.9.13 for setting up of a CFS at Ponneri Taluk, Thiruvallur Distt. (F.No.16/21/2009-Infra 1-Vol.1)

IMC granted extension of LOI upto 30.9.2013. Chairman advised CBEC to expedite the matter of pending notification.

12. Central Warehousing Corporation - Extension of LOI for the third time w.e.f. 31.03.13 to 30.9.13 for setting up of an ICD at Kannur, Kerala (F. No. 16/10/2010-Infra 1)

IMC granted extension of LOI upto 30.9.2013.

13. Setting up of a CFS at Vishakhapatnam by Sravan Shipping Services Pvt. Ltd.-Extension of validity of LOI by six months (1st extension) (F.No.16/32/2011-Infra 1)

No representative of the company was present to explain the case. Moreover, the status of progress made so far is still awaited from the company. IMC deferred the case for next meeting.

14. Extension of LOI granted to Kesar Terminals & Infrastructure Ltd., Mumbai for setting up of a CFS at Pipavav Port, Gujarat (1st extension) (F.No.16/26/2010-Infra 1)

The company representative informed that Compound wall and earth work has been completed. IMC approved the extension of LOI for nine months i.e. upto 16-11-2013. The company representative was directed to submit the progress report.

15. Extension of LOI granted to M/s. Pearl Ports & Warehousing Pvt. Ltd. for setting up an ICD at Hosur in Krishnagiri District, Tamil Nadu (1st extension) (F.No.16/05/2011-Infra 1)

The company representative informed that construction work has already started. After considering the progress made so far, IMC approved extension of LOI for six months i.e. upto 30-11-2013.

VIII. NEW PROPOSALS

16. Pristine Mega Logistics Park Private Limited –Setting up of a Rail Linked ICD at Ludhiana near Chawa Payal Railway Station, Distt. Ludhiana, Punjab (F. No. 16/5/13-Infra-I)

IMC approved the project. Formal LOI will be issued after getting comments of CBEC.

17. Setting up of Rail linked ICD at Patna Near Bihta Railway Station, Patna, Bihar by Pristine Magadh Infrastructure Pvt. Ltd., New Delhi. (F. No. 16/6/13-Infra 1)

It was decided that land details be examined on file. Comments of IMC members (CBEC & M/o Railways) are also awaited. IMC deferred the proposal for next meeting.

18. Setting up of a CFS on Ennore Express High Road at Tiruvottiyur, Chennai by STP Services Private Limited. (F.No.16/7/13-Infra 1)

IMC discussed the case in detail. It was decided that CBEC will look into the issue pertaining to staff constraints and send their comments. The case was deferred for next meeting.

19. Setting up Container Freight Station (CFS) for Seal verification of Export Container by Chennai Port Trust. (F. No.16/14/2013-Infra-I)

IMC approved the project subject to concurrence of CBEC.

20. Setting up of Container Freight Station on lease land in Plot No. 7 & 8 at EXIM Park area at Visakhapatnam by APSWC. (F. No. 16/16/2013-Infra 1)

Since the comments are awaited from CBEC and M/o Shipping, IMC deferred the proposal for next meeting.

21. Application from Cochin Port Trust requesting formal notification of their CFS in the Cochin Port operational since 1995 as an extension of the 'Ernakulam Wharf', Willingdon Island. (F. No. 16/19/2013-Infra-I)

IMC approved the proposal.

IX. OTHER AGENDA

22. Problems at JNPT while commissioning new CFS projects in and around JNPT (F. No. 16/8/2013-Infra 1)

It was decided that M/o Shipping will look into the issue pertaining to excess capacity of existing CFSs in JNPT area and send their comments. The matter was deferred for next meeting.
