



**Updated Notification on the Charging System for the Technical Services rendered
by the Research Department of the Coffee Board to the Coffee Industry**

The Coffee Board had revised the Charges for the various Technical Services rendered by Research Department of Coffee Board in September 2016, to partly support the cost of the Services and more importantly to bring the visibility to the Services rendered by the Research Department of the Coffee Board.

The Research Department has recently revised the Charges for some of the Institutional Training Programme (condensed, management & short-term executive training programme) being organized at Central Coffee Research Institute, Chikkamagaluru, considering the man-power resources utilized.

Further to the above, the Research Department of the Coffee Board has introduced charges for some of the Technical Services like pursuing project work, study tours of students to the institute and internship (one-day/one week) and specific diagnostic/problem solving, field visits of scientists which have not been covered in the previous charging system.

In view of the above, the Notification on the Charging System for the Technical Services rendered issued earlier by the Research Department of the Coffee Board has been revised accordingly.

The revised charges for the Institutional Training Programme and newly introduced Technical Services have come into effect from June 2018.
