Horizontal Commitments

- 1) The Duration of stay may be extended.
- 2) Remove discriminatory treatment in respect of social security or insurance contributions.
- 3) Undertake to put in place a Visa system to ensure the fulfillment of the Horizontal and Sectoral commitments undertaken.
- 4) Take full commitments in respect of independent professionals delinking from commercial presence. Remove restriction that market access is only allowed to professions set out in Chart A and allow access for all professionals.
- 5) Undertake to put in place a Visa System ensuring grant of multiple entry visas for professionals.
- 6) Allow inter-firm mobility to professionals
